



Addendum #1 to the 2026 Town of Midland Election Procedures – Internet/Telephone Voting

CHANGING OFFICES

The *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, MEA (the Act) section 36(a) states:

36 *A person may withdraw his or her nomination by filing a written withdrawal in the clerk's office,*

(a) before 2 p.m. on nomination day, if the person was nominated under subsection 33 (4);

(b) before 2 p.m. on the Wednesday following nomination day, if the person was nominated under subsection 33 (5).

Process:

If a candidate has filed an earlier nomination for an office in the same election, the first nomination shall be deemed to have been withdrawn at the time the second nomination is filed. A nomination form is not transferable. The filing fee is deemed to have been paid with the latest filing if the two nominations are for the same council or local board.

If a candidate is submitting a new nomination, it is advisable to require a candidate to withdraw one nomination before submitting another. [Form EL19).
